



SNOW SCHOOL HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

(Updated as of November 9, 2021)

The Snow School and daycare teams at all SkiBig3 resorts have developed health & safety protocols for the 2021/2022 season, to give parents peace of mind and to ensure the well-being of children and staff on the resorts.

For adult group lessons, and children 12 and older, proof of vaccination (or proof of negative test results) is required for all snow school programs at all resorts. Details on group lessons for children under 12 can be found below.

BANFF SUNSHINE

GROUP LESSONS

- Children under 12 who entered Canada within the last 14 days may participate in group lessons.
- Children under 12 who entered Canada within the last 14 days cannot do lunch add-ons. (Must return to parent for the break).
- Children under 12 who entered Canada within the last 14 days can go inside, if needed, wearing a mask.
- All children will be screened for symptoms upon arrival.
- Children 12 or older require proof of vaccine or negative test results within 72 hours or medical exemption. (Children 12-17 years do not require ID).

DAYCARE

- Children who entered Canada within the last 14 days are excluded from accessing Daycare services.
- Daycare staff may ask for proof of entry to Canada.
- All children will be screened for symptoms upon arrival and throughout the day, by Daycare staff.
- Masks are not required for children under 2 years.
- Children, over 2 years, registered in the Daycare will not have to wear masks in Daycare. They will, however, be required to have a mask because indoor masking requirements still apply elsewhere at the resort (gondola, TeePee Town LX chairlift, other indoor lodge spaces).

LAKE LOUISE SKI RESORT

GROUP LESSONS

- Children under 12 who entered Canada within the last 14 days may participate in group lessons.
- Children of parents who have been vaccinated and children of parents who have not been vaccinated may both participate in group lessons and may be mixed in groups.
- All children will be screened for symptoms upon arrival.
- Children 12 or older require proof of vaccine or negative test results within 72 hours or medical exemption. (Children 12-17 years do not require ID).

DAYCARE

- Protocols are being still being reviewed.

MT. NORQUAY

GROUP LESSONS

- Children under 12 who entered Canada within the last 14 days may participate in group lessons.
- Children under 12 who entered Canada within the last 14 days cannot do lunch add-ons. (Must return to parent for the break).
- Children under 12 who entered Canada within the last 14 days can go inside, if needed, wearing a clean, dry mask.
- Children who entered Canada within the last 14 days will be required to wear a face-covering in lift lines and while riding the lift with their instructor/group.
- All children will be screened for symptoms upon arrival.
- Children 12 or older require proof of vaccine or negative test results within 72 hours or medical exemption. (Children 12-17 years do not require ID).
- Unvaccinated parents may drop off their children to attend snow school (there will be a 5-minute drop zone). Unvaccinated parents may not go onto the resort.

DAYCARE

- Mt. Norquay will not be offering Daycare services for the foreseeable future.
